#### **Fundraising for Emergency Repairs**

We have an emergency repairs project for St. Luke's. Ian Hatfield of Peak Construction has agreed to take on the **Steeple Repair Project** at an estimated cost of \$50,000. Duane Giberson has agreed to repair the damage to the **Stone Foundation** of the church on the northeast corner, at an estimated cost of \$3000. Both jobs to be done this fall.

Now that we know we need \$53,000 to carry out the repairs, we must turn our attention to raising the necessary funds. This will mean employing a number of strategies.
